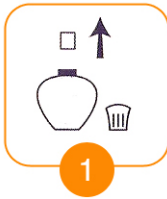


## Lampe Berger Instructions



### To use your Lampe Berger for the first time:

1. Place your Lampe Berger on a stable surface away from any source of heat. Remove the open shade and the snuffer cap.



2. Using the funnel that comes with your lampe or the pour cap accessory (sold separately), **fill your Lampe Berger to about 2/3 full with Lampe Berger fuel.** (Wipe up any fuel that spills on the outside of the lampe.)



3. Insert the wick fully into the metal neck of the Lampe Berger, making sure that the stone comes to rest firmly on the opening. Place the snuffer cap over the stone and leave the wick to soak for **at least 20 minutes.**



4. Light the stone using a lighter or match. Leave the flame to burn for a **complete 2 minutes.** Blow out the flame.

**Warning:** *never place the open shade over the flame.*



5. Your Lampe Berger is now operating! Never touch the stone during operation—place the open shade over the stone to protect your hands from the hot stone. A burning time of 25 to 45 minutes is sufficient for a room of 200-300 square feet.



6. To extinguish your Lampe Berger, carefully remove the open shade (which may be hot) and place the snuffer cap on the stone. **Important:** *if you do not place the snuffer cap on the stone, the lampe will continue to operate until it runs out of fuel.* Place the open shade over the snuffer cap. It is not necessary to remove the lampe's wick and stone after use.

### For continued use:

To reuse your Lampe Berger, repeat steps 4, 5 and 6, above. Your Lampe Berger should always be between half and 2/3 full of Lampe Berger fuel. If you've allowed the lampe to run dry, you'll need to soak the wick again (repeat all steps, above).
